Registration Instructions

Teams can be any size, but all members of the team must be in school years 6 to 11.

You will need the help of one or two adults; this could be a member of your family, teacher or a youth worker. Your project should be Community Safety or Crime Reduction based and you can make it as simple or as complex as you like.

You must keep a Team Diary as a record of your progress and its contents will be judged at the end of the project. Your Diary can include photographs, press clippings or letters. The Diary and Information Pack will be sent to you once the Adult Volunteer checks are complete.

Lifestyle Start Date – 1 April 2010 onwards

Application Closing Date – 31 August 2010

Diary Closing Date – 30 September 2010

Judging – October 2010

Winners notified – November 2010

The Lifestyle Volunteers Project is not about fund raising. Whilst we know some teams will need to raise funds to complete their projects, the winning teams will not be judged on how much money they raise. Your project must have one of the following themes: Staying Safe, Knife Crime Awareness, Community Safety or Keeping Healthy.

Rules and Conditions

- Lifestyle Volunteers is open to young people who live or are in education or training within the county of South Yorkshire
- To enter the competition young people must be in the school years 6 – 11
- Teams must be made up of at least two young people
- Teams cannot be made up entirely of Young People whose parents work for either South Yorkshire Police or any of the competition sponsors
- Each team must have at least one adult volunteer to a maximum of two, who must sign the registration form to indicate that they are willing to supervise the team and their activities and to consent to a suitability check being processed by South Yorkshire Police
- All teams must register themselves for Lifestyle Volunteers by completing the Registration Form and sending it back to
